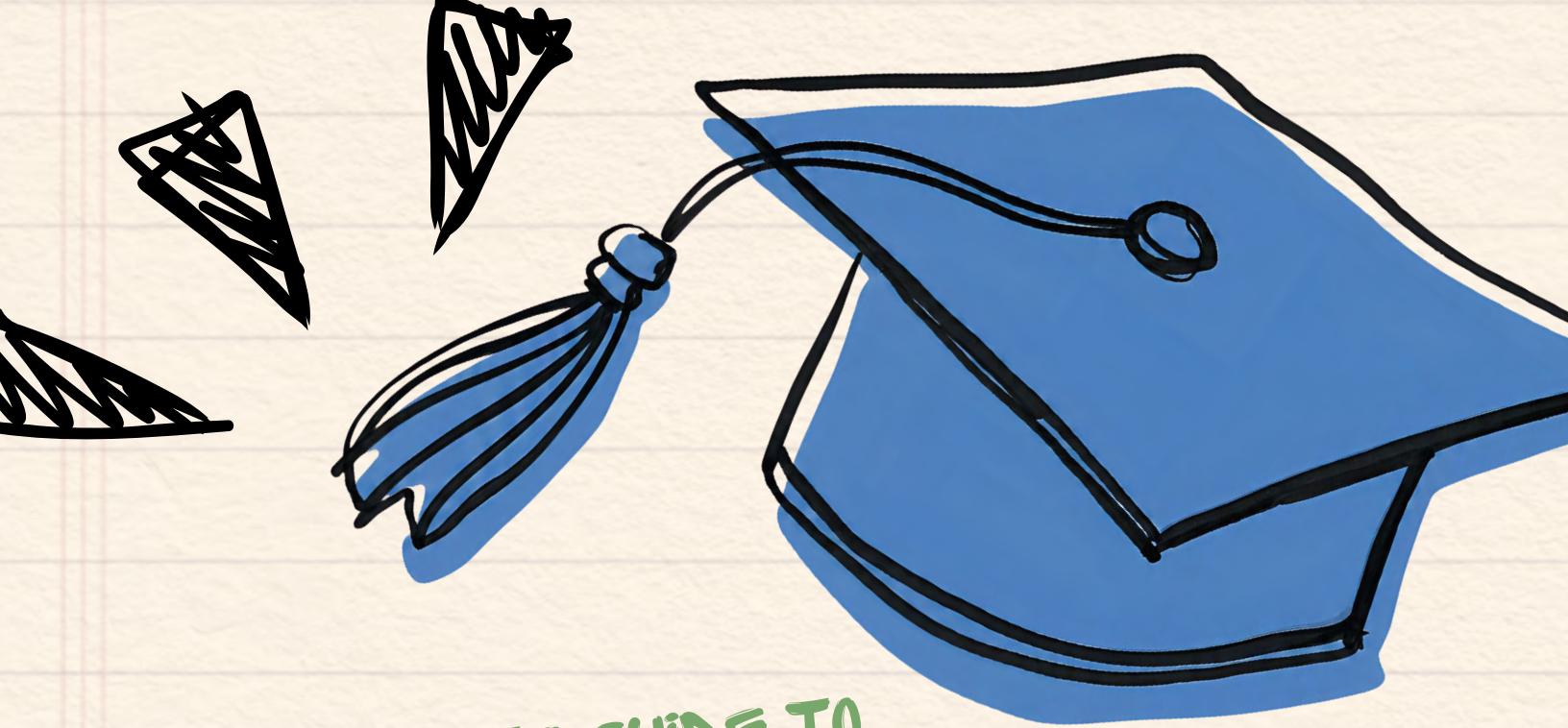

If someone looked you in the eye and asked what you want to do for the rest of your life, could you answer with real confidence?

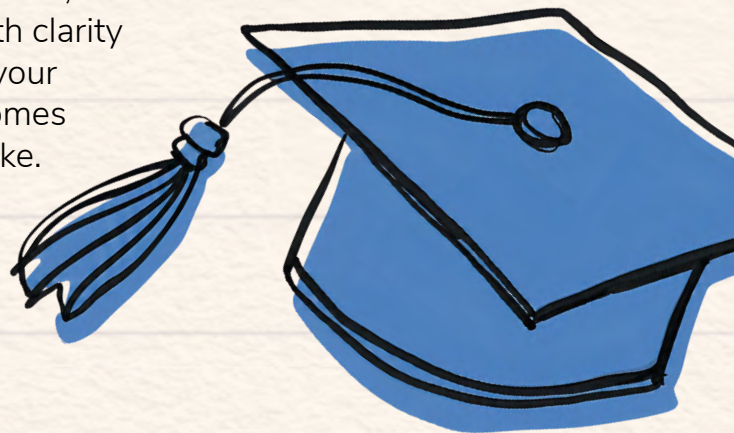

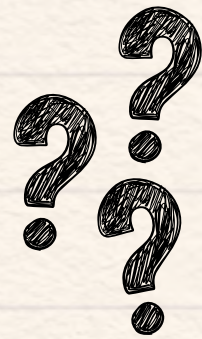
